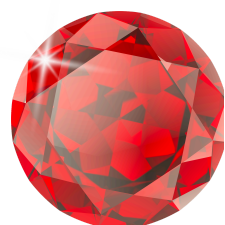

Do Not Remain Silent During this Election. Be a Voice: VOTE!

We know from the research of the Charlotte Lozier Institute that pro-life laws help women choose life, save babies, and save women from coercion and unsafe women's medical procedures. However, in Michigan all the laws that regulated abortion were removed and now allow painful late-term abortions through all nine months of pregnancy and increased the dangers for women and girls.

This November 5th the elections will impact the future either for laws that are life-affirming or laws supporting more abortion and death in our state and country. Elections have consequences!

Voting early in-person just began Saturday 10/26 and runs through Sunday 11/3 at the Muskegon County building (previously Baker College campus) 1903 Marquette Ave. for most Muskegon County residence. Please check online to make sure this is your early in-person voting location. It is suggested to vote early in-person and not to mail-in, if possible. Once you vote, you will be removed from the door-to-door, mailing, and the annoying, yet necessary call lists. That way campaigns can focus on contacting others to remind them to get out to vote by 11/5!

Remaining silent is not an option! Proverbs 31:8 says, "Speak out on behalf of the voiceless!" P.S. Take a like-minded friend or family member with you to the early vote location.
